St. Joseph Campus

1. Excavating ground east of PLC is complete and all waste has been removed.
2. Tuck pointing of the Church has been approved and estimated to be completed by year-end or next Spring.
3. Blacktop work will be complete this month. This includes repairing areas north of school and the PLC parking lot as well as sealing and striping everything.
4. The cemetery drive will be blacktopped this month.
5. The final phase of the cemetery fence replacement will be complete this month.

St. Paul Campus

1. Discussing electrical improvements that need to be made around campus (that will also benefit the festival).
