- **Maintenance Committee:**
 - Maintenance committee is working on a scope of work for a new roof and HVAC system for the GSC at St. Joseph campus. Tuck pointing of St. Joe's campus will begin in spring along with blacktopping. St. John's cemetery blacktopping will also begin in spring.

- Adult Faith Formation: Discussion deferred. With Bruce Weaver stepping back, tabled next steps related to 'testament of faith journey' for review once Christine Eppert is established in her role.
- Lenten Mission: March 1st thru March 3rd. All night covered for beverages, food. Setup and Clean-up to be completed by the group providing refreshments for the scheduled evening.
- Catholic Schools Week: Discussion around casting a wider net to include/add schools from other areas, especially for consideration for older students and/or pre-schools. Encourage attendance of school administrators to be able to address handling of tuition and other administrative items. Consideration for potential perpetual fund to establish set scholarship amounts. Stipulation for volunteer hours should be made mandatory by the parish, thus requiring families receiving scholarships to meet a volunteer hours commitment. Scholarships are not needs-based; nor do they require academic accomplishment to keep the scholarship in place.
