- **Maintenance Committee:**

 - Festivals - Fr. Meyer stressed how the Festivals are part of our Community. Council discussed how we may be able to adapt to the current COVID-19 situation, but still have a Community event. Council will be meeting again in a couple of weeks to discuss additional ideas.

X. Pastor's Comments / Purpose Fulfilled:

- Fr. Meyer commented how there has been a noticeable increase in Family to Family help. Food Pantry giving has increased along with the need. Parishioners have stepped up to donate and help as needed.
