- **Finance Committee:** Kelly Beck
 - 2 new committee members Julie Baker and Kathy Martini
 - Randy Maxwell will be new chair, replacing Kelly Beck
 - Reviewed tithing from envelopes and e-giving (\$588,098.98) and compared it to the collection budget (\$569,333.36). E-giving is at 26%.

 - Pending approved (unpaid) projects:*
 - Tuck-pointing:
 - St. Joseph estimate: \$31,900
 - Paul Girty will do snow removal at St John's, Rehage's will do St Paul's and St Martin's.

St. Martin Campus

- Michael Schwebach is working on his Eagle Scout project which is an awning addition on the front of the hall with a blacktop drive to serve as a drive through/ drop off. Everything is approved and underway.
- Fr Meyer and Mark Schmidl will be creating a gothic pulpit in the Church.

St. Joseph Campus

- Electric is currently be run to the cemetery for the flag pole and additional cemetery lighting.
- New roof is needed on Church, small rectory and Good Shepherd Center

St. John the Baptist Campus

- Blacktop new cemetery drive- complete
- Facility group still wishes to proceed with a hall addition. Finance Council present facility group with questions to answer.
- Seminarians will be moving into the parish office at Thanksgiving for approximately 6 weeks.
 - o Twin bed frames are needed to help with the sleeping arrangements
- The pews in the Church will be refinished sometime between Nov 1 and Dec 1.

St. Paul Campus

- Tree trimming complete
- 2 statue (John & Mary) and 1 angel have been ordered for cemetery
- Emily requested bids for softer playground type mulch
- People struggle to open the heavy front doors on the Church. A closer would be helpful. Weather stripping continues to fall off.
