I. Opening

III. Approval of March Meeting Minutes:

1. Committee Updates:

- **Proposals/Bids for Review**

- Adding arches to cemetery entrance at St Martin's (1) and St Paul's (2). Bid reviewed and we approved Finance committee suggestions.
- Add padding to walls at St Joseph's PLC. Bids reviewed and Finance committee's suggestion of using Borgman approved. Also noted that CYO donated \$1000 to this project.
- Extension of parish driveway on south side of office. Bids reviewed and discussion asking if there is need for additional parking with the large lot in the back. Approved (1 dissent) Finance committee's suggestion of using Steve Voegel's bid with keeping dirt on premises for future use.
- Add monuments with the 10 commandments at each campus. Discussion on options and possible alternatives to locations. In addition, this project may be used as an Eagle project in the future. Group agreed to table the passage for now to let facilities group do more review. Emily will contact Darlene to provide update.
- Painting ST Paul's exterior windows. Bids reviewed and approved Finance committee's suggestion of using "Paintin' Wagon" for work.
- Add fencing around preschool play area. Bids reviewed and agreed with Finance Committee's suggestion of using Simpson for project. Emily will

continue working on getting grants for work from the angle of safety for the children. Part two of this project will be changing the ground surface to turf. Also hope to have this covered by the grant.

2. Old Business

- **Lenten Series review**
 - General feeling is that it was well received but based on attendance, people would prefer a catechetical teaching. Fr. Meyer wants to consider doing presentation on “The Passion” next year.
- **St. Paul’s campus festival chairman**
 - Looks like Jerry Graf and Larry Joerger will make sure the festival runs. Not the best solution but for now that is what we have.
- **Anniversary Committee – organizer search**
 - No feedback has been received and we need to keep putting information out about the need. Fr Meyer agreed to do a “pulpit pitch” after Easter.
- **Easter Egg Hunts after all Masses**
 - Decided that eggs are not needed for next year and that the children should take them home. Therefore we only need people to hide eggs, make announcement after Mass and snap a photo of the children.
