DEPOSITS & FINAL PAYMENTS

Please complete the registration form and mail it with your deposit of \$250 per person to secure a reservation. A second payment (\$2500) is due December 31, 2023. Final payment (\$2495) is due July 15, 2024. Make checks payable to Kairos Travel. Deposit is fully refundable until March 1, 2024.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

In the event of cancellation, which must be in writing to Kairos Travel, the following per person charges will apply:



ITINERARY

Day 1 - October 14:

Depart Chicago (ORD)

Our visit begins as we make our way to Tel Aviv. Dinner on board.

Day 2 - October 15:

Tel Aviv (B,D)

We will be greeted at Ben Gurion International Airport by our local guide. We will settle into our nearby hotel.

Day 3 - October 16:

Caesarea, Haifa, Mt. Carmel, Cana, Nazareth (B,D)

Drive to Caesarea, once the capital of the Roman Province, and see Roman and Crusader remains, and the harbor from which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Drive on to Haifa and enjoy a panoramic view from Mount Carmel. Mass at Mt Carmel. Continue onto Nazareth and visit the Church of the Annunciation for Mass. Renew marriage vows at Cana. Continue to Tiberias to stay in our hotel on the Sea of Galilee for two nights.

Day 4 - October 17:

Tiberias, Sea of Galilee (B,D)

Some of today's highlights are a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to see the synagogue and St Peter's house, a visit to the Mount of the Beatitudes, to Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic about the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and to the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy. An unforgettable Mass will be offered near the Sea of Galilee

Day 5 - October 18:

Mt. Tabor, Jordan River, Jericho, Jerusalem (B,D)

Leave Tiberias and proceed for Mass at Mt Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. Then we visit the baptismal site on the southern shores of the Sea of Galilee. Drive to Jericho via the Jordan Valley to see the excavations of the oldest city in the world. Drive up to the Western Wall in Jerusalem, our home for the next five nights.

Day 6 - October 19:

Bethlehem, Ein Karem (B,L,D)

In the morning we visit Bethlehem to see the Church of the Nativity, and below it the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Time for Mass and a visit to Shepherd's Field. We will divide into small groups to share lunch at the homes of local Christian families. After lunch we drive to Ein Karem, the home of St John the Baptist. Back to Jerusalem.

Day 7 - October 20 (B,D)

Mass in Bethany, near the place where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Then we drive through the Judean wilderness and visit the place of the temptations of Our Lord and Qumran, the place where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Those who wish may swim in the Dead Sea.

Day 8 - October 21:

Jerusalem, Mt of Olives (B,D)

Drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem. See the Place of Ascension and the Pater Noster Church, and view the Palm Sunday road. Mass at the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. Drive down the Kidron Valley to Mt. Zion to visit the place of the Last Supper, Dormition Abbey, and St. Peter in Gallicantu built over the palace of the High Priest Caiaphas.

Day 9 - October 22:

Via Dolorosa, Holy Sepulchre (B,D)

Start the day by praying the Stations of the Cross along the Via Dolorosa. Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre where Jesus was crucified and buried, and then rose again. Visit the Church of St Anne and the pool of Bethesda. Farewell dinner.

Day 10 - October 23:

Depart Jerusalem for Tel Aviv and flight home

\$4995 per person, double occupancy. Includes: Round-trip airfare from Indianapolis. Housing in four-star hotels. Breakfast and dinner are included each day, along with transfers on arrival and departure, transportation every day by a private, modern motor coach, sightseeing with local guide and admissions, air taxes, baggage handling and gratuities for coach driver and local guide.
