The new budget provided by the Ars committee will be reviewed with the Ars committee in conjunction with the Finance council at the August meetings. As an FYI, the Archdiocese approved a two-year lease for the Ars project, and one of the conditions placed by the Archdiocese was that Ars not be a burden to the parish or its people. The hope is that Ars can capitalize on community/special events to increase overall income with the goal being to break even financially.
