1. Committee Updates:

- a. Finance Committee- Finalized budget will be available for review for the October bulletin with a comparison between the year to last year. Sunday collection totals reviewed. Parish festival report reviewed.
- b. Maintenance / Physical Facilities- No report at this time.

2. Old Business

- a. 200 yrs Catholicism in Dearborn County- 200-year celebrations are wrapping up. The year of celebrations ends on 12/31/24.

- b. Homeschooling as a Ministry- There will be ongoing discussion about the pro/cons of Homeschooling becoming an official Ministry at ASP. For this school year Fr. Hollowell has offered to pay for the insurance for the Homeschool Co-op that was in need of insurance. This will allow for the Co-op to make future plans and to allow for the decision about Homeschooling as a Ministry.
- c. CGS- Classes on our Catholic Faith- Confirmation- 1st Sacraments- Classes are starting in full swing.
- d. ARS update Interviews are ongoing for open positions. Emily and Lucy are helping during this time of transition. The Coffee Roaster is coming in to do a review and make suggestions for the future.
- e. Update-Office Recommendations (Bev & Emily)- The leadership and office structure review recommendations were given to the Pastors.
- f. Gobble Wobble- The committee is in need of volunteers to ensure success of the event. Continue to spread the word.
