**FASTING AND ABSTINENCE RULES**

- ~ Abstinence (*abstaining from meat*) and Fasting (*One meal and, if necessary, two smaller meals to maintain sufficient strength*) are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday.
- ~ All Fridays throughout the year, especially during the season of Lent are penitential days that require Abstinence.
- ~ All persons who have completed their **fourteenth (14)** year are bound by the law of abstinence; all adults are bound by the law of fast and abstinence up to the beginning of their **sixtieth (60) year**. Nevertheless, pastors and parents are to see to it that minors (under 14) who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance.
